Recently, representatives Alma Mercado and Kimberly McGowman from WRTP | BIG STEP visited Pathways High to introduce students to career pathways in skilled trades. They shared how WRTP provides hands-on, group-size preemployment training certificate programs, while BIG STEP offers individualized tutoring for apprenticeship exams. To engage students, they led a hands-on challenge where teams had 10 minutes to construct the tallest, strongest structure using only seven sheets of paper and tape—without securing it to the table. This fun activity encouraged creativity, problem-solving, and teamwork and provided insight into real-world trade skills.
